 - B. The program shall provide liability coverage for employees up to Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000.00) in coverage per occurrence.
 - C. The program shall be administered by the Office of Management and Enterprise Services (OMES). OMES shall promulgate rules to implement the provisions of this act.
 - D. OMES shall be authorized to contract liability insurance from a licensed insurer, to create a self-insured risk pool or to use a combination of both.
 - E. The insurance carrier providing any portion of coverage provided under this act shall be selected by a competitive process.
 - F. The Legislature shall provide an annual appropriation to cover the costs and any associated premiums for the program.
 - G. Each school district shall notify annually, in writing, eligible employees about the coverage provided by the Educators' Professional Liability Insurance Program.
 - H. OMES and the Department of Education shall notify, in writing, all eligible employees about the Educators' Professional Liability Insurance Program. The notice shall specifically inform employees that coverage is provided automatically as part of their
