9 An Act relating to game and fish; directing the
10 Department of Wildlife Conservation to require
11 certain tags for antelope; requiring the issuance of
12 certain number of tags for antelope; authorizing a
13 yearly statewide bag limit per person; providing for
14 codification; and providing an effective date.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
17 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 4-204 of Title 29, unless there
18 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

19 A. The Department of Wildlife Conservation shall require
20 persons taking or removing an antelope to attach a tag to the killed
21 antelope.

22 B. The Department shall issue as many tags for antelope as
23 requested by antelope hunters up to the following amounts:

24 1. For any landowner permit drawing program established by the
Department, two hundred ten tags per antelope gun season to persons

1 participating in the program; provided the Department may limit the
2 number of tags after issuing two hundred ten tags in a single
3 season; and

4 2. For any statewide controlled hunt program established by the
5 Department, two hundred ten tags per antelope gun season to persons
6 participating in the program; provided the Department may limit the
7 number of tags after issuing two hundred ten tags in a single
8 season.

9 C. The Department may impose a yearly statewide bag limit for
10 antelope per person.

11 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
