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10	An Act relating to water; amending 82 O.S. 2011, Section 1020.15, which relates to waste prohibition; clarifying language; declaring the taking and use of
11	marginal water to be considered a beneficial use; requiring the Oklahoma Water Resources Board
12	promulgate and implement certain rules; stating that any use of marginal water is in addition to any
13	domestic use or any other permitted use; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.
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16	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
17	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 82 O.S. 2011, Section 1020.15, is
18	amended to read as follows:
19	Section 1020.15 A. The Oklahoma Water Resources Board shall
20	not permit any fresh groundwater user to commit waste by:
21	1. Drilling a well, taking, or using fresh groundwater without
22	a permit, except for domestic use;
23	2. Taking more fresh groundwater than is authorized by the
24	permit;

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3. Taking or using fresh groundwater in any manner so that the
 water is lost for beneficial use;

4. Transporting fresh groundwater from a well to the place of
use in such a manner that there is an excessive loss in transit;
5. Using fresh groundwater in such an inefficient manner that
6 excessive losses occur;

6. Allowing any fresh groundwater to reach a pervious stratum
and be lost into cavernous or otherwise pervious materials
encountered in a well;

10 7. Permitting or causing the pollution of a fresh water strata 11 or basin through any act which will permit fresh groundwater 12 polluted by minerals or other waste to filter or otherwise intrude into such a basin or subbasin. The Board shall be precluded from 13 14 determining whether waste by pollution will occur pursuant to the 15 provisions of this paragraph if the activity for which the applicant 16 or water user intends to or has used the water as specified under 17 Section 1020.9 of this title is required to comply with rules and 18 requirements of or is within the jurisdictional areas of 19 environmental responsibility of the Department of Environmental 20 Quality or the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and 21 Forestry;

8. Drilling wells and producing fresh groundwater therefrom except in accordance with the well spacing previously determined by the Board;

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9. Using fresh groundwater for air conditioning or cooling
 purposes without providing facilities to aerate and reuse such
 water; or

4 10. Failure to properly plug abandoned fresh water wells in
5 accordance with rules of the Board and file reports thereof.

6 Except as otherwise provided by paragraph 7 of subsection A в. 7 of this section, any employee of the Board having evidence that an act of waste is being committed in his or her presence, or after 8 9 investigation of a complaint filed by another individual, shall take 10 steps to assure that the waste ceases. Such steps shall include but 11 shall not be limited to pursuing voluntary compliance, obtaining the 12 issuance of a cease and desist order by the Executive Director, 13 instituting action in a court of competent jurisdiction to enjoin 14 the waste, pursuing a suspension of any permit or other 15 administrative remedies by the Board, and filing a complaint in the 16 district court of the county wherein such violation has occurred, 17 and it shall be the duty of the district attorney of said county to 18 prosecute such complaint.

C. In cases of waste by pollution pursuant to paragraph 7 of subsection A of this section, any complaint or investigation, or any enforcement matter other than an individual proceeding involving the suspension of an Oklahoma Water Resources Board permit shall be referred to and subject to the jurisdiction of the Department of

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Environmental Quality or other appropriate state environmental
 agency or state agency with limited environmental responsibility.

3 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified 4 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1021.1 of Title 82, unless there 5 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

6 The ability to take and use marginal water has the potential Α. 7 to augment water supply in many areas of Oklahoma. Therefore, the taking and use of marginal water in accordance with the Oklahoma 8 9 Groundwater Law and the rules of the Oklahoma Water Resources Board 10 shall be considered a beneficial use and not waste. Except as 11 provided in this section and Sections 1020.15 and 1020.16 of Title 12 82 of the Oklahoma Statutes, the provisions of this act shall not 13 apply to the taking and use of marginal water.

14 Β. The Oklahoma Water Resources Board shall promulgate and 15 implement rules for the taking and use of marginal water, including 16 the well construction standards, well spacing, and water use 17 reporting. Rules related to well construction standards shall 18 ensure that the taking and use of marginal water shall not impair 19 any fresh water basins, and shall include, but not be limited to, 20 the rate of withdrawal, the level of perforating and the level of 21 sealing the well.

C. Any use of marginal water under this section is in addition any domestic use authorized under Section 1020.3 of Title 82 of the Oklahoma Statutes or any other use authorized pursuant to a

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1	permit issued under Section 1020.11 of Title 82 of the Oklahoma
2	Statutes.
3	SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
