14	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified

17	A. Each assisted living center in this state shall annually
18	post in a conspicuous location, no later than September 1 of each
19	year, the current Vaccine Information Statements on influenza
20	vaccines as provided by the Centers for Disease Control and
21	Prevention and other educational information on influenza disease,
22	which shall include, but not be limited to:
23	1. The risks associated with influenza disease;

- 2. The availability, effectiveness, and known contraindications of the influenza immunization;
 - 3. Causes and symptoms of influenza; and
 - 4. The means by which influenza is spread.
 - B. Nothing in this section shall be construed to require an assisted living center to provide or pay for any immunization against influenza for its residents.
 - C. No person shall have a cause of action for any loss or damage caused by any act or omission resulting from providing, or the lack of providing, educational information pursuant to this act.
 - D. The assisted living center's license shall not be affected, nor shall fines be imposed or deficiencies cited, due to the providing or lack of providing the educational information pursuant to this act.
- SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
