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7	An Act relating to the State Department of Rehabilitation Services; requiring that portions of
8	certain appropriated funds be used for certain purposes; prohibiting supplantation of funding;
9	requiring a certain amount of funding to be budgeted for a stated purpose; authorizing requests for early
10	transfers of certain funds for specific purposes; providing for lapse of funds under certain conditions
11	requiring certain budget procedures; prohibiting certain budget procedures; providing an effective
12	date; and declaring an emergency.
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15	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
16	SECTION 1. From the funds appropriated to the Department of
17	Rehabilitation Services in Enrolled House Bill No. 2765 of the 1st
18	Session of the 57th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of Nine Hundred
19	Ninety-two Thousand Eight Hundred Nineteen Dollars (\$992,819.00)
20	shall be used for the maintenance of effort for Visual Services and
21	Vocational Rehabilitation.
22	SECTION 2. From the funds appropriated to the Department of
23	Rehabilitation Services in Enrolled House Bill No. 2765 of the 1st
24	Session of the 57th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of Two Million

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Five Hundred Nine Thousand Two Hundred Ninety-three Dollars
 (\$2,509,293.00) shall be used for capital improvements at the
 Oklahoma School for the Deaf located in Sulphur, Oklahoma.

SECTION 3. From the funds appropriated to the Department of 4 5 Rehabilitation Services in Enrolled House Bill No. 2765 of the 1st Session of the 57th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of One Hundred 6 Fifty-six Thousand Dollars (\$156,000.00) shall be used for the 7 maintenance of the Oklahoma School for the Blind located in 8 9 Muskogee, Oklahoma. These funds shall not supplant current 10 maintenance funding and the agency shall budget no less than the 11 total of the amount budgeted in the fiscal year ending June 30, 12 2019, plus the amount listed above for this purpose.

SECTION 4. From the funds appropriated to the Department of 13 Rehabilitation Services in Enrolled House Bill No. 2765 of the 1st 14 15 Session of the 57th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of One Hundred Ninety-two Thousand Dollars (\$192,000.00) shall be used for the 16 17 maintenance of the Oklahoma School for the Deaf located in Sulphur, These funds shall not supplant current maintenance 18 Oklahoma. funding and the agency shall budget no less than the total of the 19 amount budgeted in the fiscal year ending June 30, 2019, plus the 20 amount listed above for this purpose. 21

22 SECTION 5. From the funds appropriated to the Department of 23 Rehabilitation Services in Enrolled House Bill No. 2765 of the 1st 24 Session of the 57th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of Ninety-one

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Thousand Three Hundred Thirty-three Dollars (\$91,333.00) shall be
 used for the teacher pay raise.

3 SECTION 6. The Director of the State Department of
4 Rehabilitation Services may request through the Director of the
5 Office of Management and Enterprise Services the early transfer by
6 the Oklahoma Tax Commission of tax collections to the General
7 Revenue Fund for the purpose of early allocation to the Department's
8 disbursing funds to alleviate cash-flow problems.

9 SECTION 7. Appropriations made by Enrolled House Bill No. 2765 10 of the 1st Session of the 57th Oklahoma Legislature, not including 11 appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2020 (hereafter FY-20), or may be 12 budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2021 (hereafter FY-21). 13 Funds budgeted for FY-20 may be encumbered only through June 30, 14 2020, and must be expended by November 15, 2020. Any funds 15 remaining after November 15, 2020, and not budgeted for FY-21, shall 16 lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then-current fiscal 17 year. Funds budgeted for FY-21 may be encumbered only through June 18 30, 2021. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2021, shall lapse 19 to the credit of the proper fund for the then-current fiscal year. 20 These appropriations shall not be budgeted in both fiscal years 21 simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-20, and not required to pay 22 obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-21, after 23 the agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared 24

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1	and submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds
2	from the FY-20 budget work program and after such revision has been
3	approved by the Office of Management and Enterprise Services.
4	SECTION 8. This act shall become effective July 1, 2019.
5	SECTION 9. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
6	of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
7	declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
8	be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
