A. Whenever any blood sample is drawn for the 15 purpose of testing for brucellosis, the person drawing the blood 16 sample shall ensure the fastening application of an official metal 17 tag identification, approved by the State Veterinarian and imprinted 18 with a distinctive number, to the right ear of the animal from which 19 20 blood is drawn. If an official ear tag identification is already fastened to the right ear, the number imprinted present, that 21 official identification shall be recorded instead of inserting a new 22 23 tag.

1	B. The person shall submit with the blood sample a written
2	report to the State Veterinarian. The report shall be signed by the
3	person drawing the sample and shall be on a form prescribed by the
4	State Veterinarian. The report shall show the <del>number on the tag</del>
5	fastened to the tested animal's ear official identification and
6	descriptive markings of the animal, or herd tattoo, if the tested
7	animal is a registered animal.

- C. It shall not be necessary to ear tag officially identify any registered animal if the herd registration tattoo of each animal is shown on the report. If the registration <a href="paper is not transferred">paper is not transferred</a> with the animal, official identification shall be applied.
- D. The removal of the identifying metal ear tag from the animal's ear official identification without prior authorization from the State Veterinarian shall be a violation of the Oklahoma Agricultural Code.
- E. Each packing plant in this state shall collect and identify a blood sample with all identification tags from each bovine animal showing the presence of the first pair of central incisors.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
