7 A Concurrent Resolution relating to the Catastrophic  
Health Emergency Powers Act and Amended Executive  
8 Order No. 2020-12 filed May 1, 2020.

10 WHEREAS, the Catastrophic Health Emergency Powers Act, 63 O.S.  
11 2011, Section 6101 et seq., provides for the Governor of the State  
12 of Oklahoma to take certain action pursuant to Executive Order; and

13 WHEREAS, Governor Stitt declared a Catastrophic Health Emergency  
14 by Executive Order No. 2020-12 filed April 2, 2020 and convoked the  
15 1st Extraordinary Session of the 57th Legislature on April 6, 2020;  
16 and

17 WHEREAS, the Catastrophic Health Emergency Powers Act provides  
18 for either approval of such Executive Order or termination of such  
19 Executive Order by action of the Legislature or an automatic  
20 termination after 30 days; and

21 WHEREAS, the Legislature properly passed House Concurrent  
22 Resolution 1 whereby concurring with the declaration of a  
23 Catastrophic Health Emergency pursuant to Section 6405 of Title 63  
24 of the Oklahoma Statutes; and

1       WHEREAS, pursuant to the amended Executive Order 2020-12 filed  
2 on May 1, 2020, Governor Kevin Stitt has reconvened the 1st  
3 Extraordinary Session of the 57th Legislature for purposes of  
4 approval or termination of the amended Executive Order 2020-12 which  
5 calls for a renewal of the Catastrophic Health Emergency after its  
6 automatic termination occurring on May 2, 2020.

7       NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE 1ST  
8 EXTRAORDINARY SESSION OF THE 57TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE HOUSE OF  
9 REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:

10       THAT the Oklahoma State Senate and the Oklahoma House of  
11 Representatives approve, but such approval shall only become  
12 effective when the President Pro Tempore of the Senate and the  
13 Speaker of the House of Representatives receive written  
14 documentation from the Governor which separately identifies the  
15 declaration of the Catastrophic Health Emergency and each of the  
16 powers authorized pursuant to Section 6101 et seq. of Title 63 of  
17 the Oklahoma Statutes and exercised by the Governor from the  
18 previous Catastrophic Health Emergency Executive Order and those  
19 powers which will continue or any powers to be newly exercised when  
20 the contingency for approval of the most recent order for  
21 declaration is met. The written documentation shall be received by  
22 the President Pro Tempore of the Senate and the Speaker of the House  
23 of Representatives within two business days after proper passage of  
24 this resolution.
