AMENDATORY 16 amended to read as follows: 17 Section 10-106. A. It shall be the duty of the principal or 18 head teacher of each public, private or other school in the State of 19 Oklahoma to keep a full and complete record of the attendance of all 20 children at such school and to notify the attendance officer of the 21 district in which such school is located of the absence of such 22 children from the school together with the causes thereof, if known; 23 and it shall be the duty of any parent, quardian or other person 24 having charge of any child of compulsory attendance age to notify

the child's teacher concerning the cause of any absences of such It shall be the duty of the principal or head teacher to notify the parent, quardian or responsible person of the absence of the child for any part of the school day, unless the parent, quardian or other responsible person notifies the principal or head teacher of such absence. Such attendance officer and teacher shall be required to report to the school health officer all absences on account of illness with such information respecting the same as may be available by report or investigation; and the attendance officer shall, if justified by the circumstances, promptly give to the parent, quardian or custodian of any child who has not complied with the provisions of this article oral and documented or written warning to the last-known address of such person that the attendance of such child is required at some public, private or other school as herein provided. If within five (5) days after the warning has been received, the parent, guardian or custodian of such child does not comply with the provisions of this article, then such attendance officer shall make complaint against the parent, guardian or custodian of such child in a court of competent jurisdiction for such violation, which violation shall be a misdemeanor. If a child is absent without valid excuse four (4) or more days or parts of days within a four-week period or is absent without valid excuse for ten (10) or more days or parts of days within a semester, the attendance officer shall notify the parent, guardian or custodian of

1	the child and immediately report such absences to the district
2	attorney in the county wherein the school is located for juvenile
3	proceedings pursuant to Title 10A of the Oklahoma Statutes.
4	B. As used in this section, "valid excuse" includes, but is not
5	limited to, absences for:
6	1. Any school-approved activity;
7	2. Participation in extracurricular activities approved by the
8	board of education or the school principal; or
9	3. Any other reason deemed appropriate by each local school
10	district.
11	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
