

- 1 1. Salaries and benefits for teachers, teaching assistants,
2 librarians, library aides and in-service teacher trainers;
- 3 2. Curriculum development;
- 4 3. Student assessments;
- 5 4. Technology for students;
- 6 5. Supplies; and
- 7 6. Purchased services related to expenditures referenced in
8 paragraphs 1 through 5 of this subsection.

9 B. The provisions of subsection A of this section shall apply
10 when related to the expenditure of public funds by school districts.
11 When reporting or publishing the instructional expenditures for any
12 purpose, the State Department of Education shall also report or
13 publish each category of instructional expenditure as listed in
14 subsection A of this section as well as the aggregate instructional
15 expenditure.

16 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2019.

17 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
18 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
19 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
20 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
