9 An Act relating to assisted living centers; requiring
10 assisted living centers to post certain information;
11 specifying information to be given; providing certain
12 construction; protecting assisted living centers from
13 certain civil and administrative actions; providing
14 for codification; and providing an effective date.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
16 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-890.7a of Title 63, unless
17 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

18 A. Each assisted living center in this state shall annually
19 post in a conspicuous location, no later than September 1 of each
20 year, the current Vaccine Information Statements on influenza
21 vaccines as provided by the Centers for Disease Control and
22 Prevention and other educational information on influenza disease,
23 which shall include, but not be limited to:

24 1. The risks associated with influenza disease;

1 2. The availability, effectiveness, and known contraindications
2 of the influenza immunization;

3 3. Causes and symptoms of influenza; and

4 4. The means by which influenza is spread.

5 B. Nothing in this section shall be construed to require an
6 assisted living center to provide or pay for any immunization
7 against influenza for its residents.

8 C. No person shall have a cause of action for any loss or
9 damage caused by any act or omission resulting from providing, or
10 the lack of providing, educational information pursuant to this act.

11 D. The assisted living center's license shall not be affected,
12 nor shall fines be imposed or deficiencies cited, due to the
13 providing or lack of providing the educational information pursuant
14 to this act.

15 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
