For purposes of Sections 3601.1 through 14 3603 of this title, the term "employee" means a full-time employee 15 or any number of part-time employees whose combined weekly hours of 16 employment equal those of a full-time employee, but shall not 17 include temporary employees working on a seasonal basis between May 18 1 and October 31. 19 Beginning July 1, 2008, the maximum number of full-time-20 equivalent employees for each of the following agencies, boards, 21 commissions, departments, or programs shall not exceed the numbers 22 specified in this section, except as may be authorized pursuant to 23 the provisions of Section 3603 of this title.
