10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

11 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
12 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1133.4 of Title 47, unless there  
13 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

14 A. No state agency, unless required under federal law, shall  
15 require any single or combination farm use vehicle included in this  
16 section to participate in the United States Department of  
17 Transportation identification numbering system.

18 B. For the purposes of this section, single or combination farm  
19 use vehicle is a vehicle or vehicles with a gross combined weight  
20 rating of more than twenty-six thousand one (26,001) pounds if:

21 1. It is entitled to be registered with a farm tag and has a  
22 farm tag attached thereto;

23 2. It is controlled and operated by a farmer or rancher, his or  
24 her family or employees;

1           3. It is used to transport either agricultural products,  
2 livestock, farm machinery, farm supplies or any combination of those  
3 materials to or from a farm;

4           4. It is not used in the operations of a common or contract  
5 motor carrier;

6           5. It is used within this state or within one hundred fifty  
7 (150) air miles of the person's farm or ranch if traveling out of  
8 state; and

9           6. It is not transporting hazardous materials as defined under  
10 the Oklahoma Motor Carrier Safety and Hazardous Materials  
11 Transportation Act.

12           SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
