1 Dollars (\$10.00) for each instrument recorded with the Registrar of 2 Deeds.

3 There is hereby created a fund to be known as the "County D. Clerk's Records Management and Preservation Fund". The fund shall 4 5 be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year limitations, and shall consist of the fees and monies accruing to the fund, as 6 prescribed in subsection C of this section with all monies accruing 7 to the fund to be expended by the clerk and not transferred to any 8 9 other fund. The intent of this section is to increase the net 10 funding level available to the county clerk to maintain and preserve 11 public records.

E. The fees and costs prescribed in this section shall not apply to child support enforcement offices operated by or on behalf of the Department of Human Services' Child Support Enforcement Division. County clerks shall not charge any fees or costs to such offices, the Division, or the Department.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
