6	An Act relating to livestock diseases; amending 2
7	O.S. 2011, Section 6-93, which relates to identification of animals from which blood samples
8	are drawn; modifying identification requirement; clarifying statutory language; requiring application
9	of official identification under certain circumstance; removing requirement; and providing an
10	effective date.

12	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
13	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 2 O.S. 2011, Section 6-93, is
14	amended to read as follows:
15	Section 6-93. A. Whenever any blood sample is drawn for the
16	purpose of testing for brucellosis, the person drawing the blood
17	sample shall ensure <del>the fastening</del> <u>application</u> of <del>an</del> official <del>metal</del>
18	tag identification, approved by the State Veterinarian and imprinted
19	with a distinctive number, to the right ear of the animal from which
20	<del>blood is drawn</del> . If <del>an</del> official <del>ear tag</del> <u>identification</u> is already
21	fastened to the right ear, the number imprinted present, that
22	official identification shall be recorded instead of inserting a new
23	<del>tag</del> .

- 1 The person shall submit with the blood sample a written 2 report to the State Veterinarian. The report shall be signed by the 3 person drawing the sample and shall be on a form prescribed by the State Veterinarian. The report shall show the number on the tag 4 5 fastened to the tested animal's ear official identification and descriptive markings of the animal, or herd tattoo, if the tested 6 animal is a registered animal. 7 C. It shall not be necessary to ear tag officially identify any 9 registered animal if the herd registration tattoo of each animal is 10 shown on the report. If the registration paper is not transferred
  - D. The removal of the identifying metal car tag from the animal's car official identification without prior authorization from the State Veterinarian shall be a violation of the Oklahoma Agricultural Code.

with the animal, official identification shall be applied.

- E. Each packing plant in this state shall collect and identify a blood sample with all identification tags from each bovine animal showing the presence of the first pair of central incisors.
- SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
