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13	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
14	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 5028.2 of Title 63, unless there
16	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
17	A. The Oklahoma Health Care Authority shall initiate requests
18	for proposals for a pilot program to examine the feasibility of
19	transforming the current Medicaid program from a fee-for-service
20	payment model to a value-based payment model utilizing a provider-
21	led accountable care organization. The pilot program shall begin no
22	later than January 1, 2022.
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1	B. The pilot program implemented by the accountable care
2	organization shall contain, but not be limited to, the following
3	components:
4	1. Value-based purchasing;
5	2. Quality measurements;
6	3. Data-sharing and integration;
7	4. Care management;
8	5. Provider and community collaboration; and
9	6. Preservation of the Supplemental Hospital Offset Payment
10	Program.
11	C. The Oklahoma Health Care Authority Board shall promulgate
12	rules to implement the provisions of this act.
13	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2020.
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
