C. 1. Licensed growers shall be responsible for ensuring that all batches of marijuana sold by the grower to a licensed processor or dispensary have been tested in accordance with the testing program created by the State Department of Health pursuant to this section.

8 2. Licensed processors shall be responsible for ensuring that
9 all batches of marijuana products sold by the processor to a
10 licensed dispensary or another licensed processor have been tested
11 in accordance with the testing program created by the State
12 Department of Health pursuant to this section.

D. The State Commissioner of Health shall promulgate such rules
as are necessary to implement the provisions of this section.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
