**Research Analysis**

HB 1019 clarifies the evidentiary requirements for preliminary examinations and removes the district attorney as the arbiter of determining the release of law enforcement reports prior to a preliminary hearing. The measure extends the time for discovery to be completed from at least 10 days prior to trial to within 20 days of receiving a request.
