Research Analysis

The Senate amendments to HB1230 mostly include cleanup language and make no substantive changes to the bill.

HB1230 relates to the Lindsey Nicole Henry (LNH) Scholarships for Students with Disabilities Program. The measure requires the State Department of Education (SDE) to list on its website all associations it has approved to accredit private schools in the LNH program.

HB1230 requires the SDE to list on its website all information and material submitted by the private school with its application to be in the LNH program.

The measure also requires the SDE to post on its website the annual compliance statement for each participating private school.

Furthermore, HB1230 requires the SDE to annually prepare and post to its website a report of the LNH program, and include:

- The total number and amount of scholarships for each participating private school
- The total number of scholarships denied
- The total number of scholarship payments suspended for each private school
- Data on participating students including economically disadvantaged status and disability category
