Research Analysis

HB 1925 creates a complimentary beverage license which authorizes the holder to provide, free of charge for on-premises consumption only, no more than two alcoholic beverages containing spirits, twelve ounces of wine or twenty-four ounces of beer per day. The measure limits the license to businesses involved in retail sales or services. The license is \$75 with a surcharge of \$25.

Fiscal Analysis

HB 1925, which creates a complementary beverage license, upon review and along with consultation by ABLE, is determined to have positive impact on ABLE as well as the General Revenue Fund. The entirety of the \$75 fee goes to general revenue and the surcharge goes to ABLE. The exact revenue increase to both is dependent upon how many licenses are issued.
