Minimal Positive Revenue from Motor Vehicle Collections

Research Analysis

HB 2664 authorizes the Oklahoma Tax Commission to issue a "vintage vehicle" certificate of title for cars and trucks for which no Oklahoma certificate of title exists in the records of the Oklahoma Tax Commission prior to January 1, 1980, and which has not been registered in the records of the Oklahoma Tax Commission or any other state for a period of fifteen or more years. The fee for a vintage vehicle title is \$250. Applicable sales and excise tax must also be paid. Once a certificate of title has been issued for a vintage vehicle is subject to the annual registration requirements in the same manner and subject to the same fees as provided by law for other motor vehicles.
