Research Analysis

HB 2877 increases the fee for a victim/offender reconciliation program and victims impact panel program to \$75. The measure prohibits a certified assessment agency, certified assessor or provider of an alcohol and drug substance abuse course from providing a victims impact panel program and prohibits a certified assessment agency, certified assessor or provider of an alcohol and drug substance abuse course from having any proprietary or pecuniary interest in a victims impact panel program. The measure requires providers of a victims impact panel program to provide to the District Attorneys Council a registration fee of \$1,000 and a statement certifying that the provider has complied with all necessary requirements.

HB 2877, which establishes a \$1,000 victims impact panel registration fee that will go to the District Attorneys Council (DAC), is expected to create an annual revenue increase for the agency between \$2,000-\$3,000.
