**Research Analysis**

HB 3663 modifies the basis for removal of a motor license agent by the Tax Commission. The measure directs that the removal of an agent “for cause”. Currently, agents are considered “at will”.

**Fiscal Analysis**

HB 3663, in its current form, changes the language surrounding the removal of motor license agents. The change makes the removal of a motor license agent “for cause” rather than “at the will of” the Tax Commission.

Analysis provided by the Tax Commission estimates this measure to have no direct impact on revenues for FY’21.
