Research Analysis

SB 147 requires school district superintendents to file a statement with the State Board of Education detailing the credit deficiency of any student in the 9th – 12th grade that has been granted a transfer into their district. A determination of deficiency shall be based on the student's progress toward meeting state graduation requirements.

The State Board of Education is required to annually post a report on its website containing information about the districts that students are transferring out of, and the types of credit deficiencies those students experience. The report shall not include the names of students.
