## **Research Analysis**

SB 316 requires a state agency to report online any Memorandum of Understanding or Memorandum of Agreement with any other agency, department or any organization receiving appropriations, grants or contracts from the State of Oklahoma or any other state, or funds from the federal government. The agency would also be required to submit a copy to the chair of the appropriate legislative committee. Finally, a memorandum must cite the constitutional or statutory authority granted for the subject it addresses.

## **Fiscal Analysis**

SB 316 in its current form requires state agencies to make available online memorandums of understanding and memorandums of agreement entered into by the agency. It is assumed such document upload functions will be absorbable within existing agency budgetary resource structures. For this reason SB 316 in its current form will have no direct fiscal impact on the state budget or revenues.
