Fiscal Analysis

Provisions include an increase in the fee charged by county clerks for each instrument recorded with the Registrar of Deeds. The fee is increased from \$5.00 per instrument to \$10.00. County association officials indicate the available data for providing a reliable estimate is currently unavailable. There is a likely increase in fee revenue which will offset increased capability for document preservation, maintaining and archiving recorded instruments.
