<b>Impact:</b>	<b>CIB: Currently has no method to calculate lost commercial endorsement revenues. No dollar amount can be determined by this nonappropriated agency.</b>

**Research Analysis**

SB 743 requires labor-only subcontractors performing the labor of roofing installation to be registered under the Roofing Contractor Registration Act. They would not be required to have a commercial endorsement but would be required to be supervised by a full-time employee of the commercial-endorsed contractor.
