**Research Analysis**

SB768 requires the State Department of Health to mail a medical marijuana applicant's approval or rejection letter within 30 business days of receiving the application. Beginning April 1, 2021, the Department will have 14 calendar days to mail an approval or rejection letter.

The measure also requires the State Department of Health to mail an approval or rejection letter to medical marijuana dispensary license applicants, commercial grower license applicants, and medical marijuana processor license applicants within 90 business days of receiving an application. Beginning April 1, 2021, the Department will have 14 calendar days to mail an approval or rejection letter.
