Research Analysis

SB92 requires public schools to be evaluated once every four years to determine whether they meet state accreditation standards. Schools shall be evaluated annually to determine if they meet standards tied to federal funding, health and safety standards, and the certification requirements for teachers, principals and superintendents.

The measure requires schools that receive a deficiency in accreditation to be evaluated annually until they have received no deficiencies for two consecutive years, at which point they will return to being evaluated once every four years.
