**Research Analysis**

The Floor Amendment to SB92 adds language requiring the evaluations to happen once every four years on a schedule adopted by the State Board of Education.

The amendment also adds language allowing the State Board of Education to interrupt the evaluation schedule for reasons including a change in the superintendent of the school district; determination that one or more school district board members have not met the continuing education requirements as defined by this title; determination that the school district falsified information submitted to the any public city, county, state or federal official or agency; initiation of an investigation by the Board or a law enforcement agency or other determination by the Board that standards for accreditation are not being met by the school district.
