Bill Analysis

HB 2846 creates the Oklahoma Kratom Consumer Protection Act. The measure regulates the sale of kratom by requiring such products to not be mixed with a dangerous nonkratom substance. A kratom product is adulterated with a dangerous nonkratom substance if the kratom product is mixed or packed with a nonkratom substance affecting the quality or strength of the product to such a degree as to render the kratom product injurious to a consumer. Vendors are also prohibited from selling a kratom product if it contains a level of 7-hydroxymitragynine in the alkaloid fraction that is greater than 2%. The measure also requires kratom products to be appropriately labeled.
