**Bill Analysis**

SB 1022 defines terms related to Oklahoma and United States citizenship. The measure defines a citizen of the United States, and subject to the jurisdiction thereof, as a person those individuals born inside of or outside of the United States to at least one parent with United States citizenship and excludes person born in the United States to foreign nationals. Only persons born in the United States and subject to the jurisdiction thereof shall be deemed to be citizens of Oklahoma upon meeting the residency requirements of this section.
