**Committee Substitute (CS)**

The CS for SB 110 allows agencies erecting a building that has a pre-fabrication design and has already undergone engineering design and building standards to forego the process of contracting for any engineering or architectural services. Such projects are also exempted from the provisions of the State Architectural and Registered Interior Designers Act and will not require an architect if the project does not exceed two stories in height. Other civil, structural, fire protection, mechanical and electrical engineering requirements shall be determined by the authorities having jurisdiction and the applicable building code.
