**Bill Analysis**

SB 1219 directs the Oklahoma Health Care Authority to initiate requests for proposals for a pilot program that shall examine the feasibility of transforming the Medicaid program from a fee-for-service payment model to a value-based payment model utilizing a provider-led accountable care organization. The measure outlines the content of what the pilot program shall contain. The pilot program shall begin no later than January 1, 2022.
