**Committee Substitute (CS)**

The CS for SB 1436 authorizes the State Board of Education to issue provisional and standard teaching certificates in the area of comprehensive special education as well as issue two-year provisional teaching certificates in severe-profound disabilities. The measure establishes eligibility for the certificate. Individuals who meet the requirements for a 2-year provisional certificate may be issued a standard certificate in severe-profound disabilities upon completion of a microcredentialing program approved by the Board or a subject area competency examination.
