Bill Analysis

SB 1527 restricts the use of heat as a method of pest control to commercial applicators licensed under the Combined Pesticide Law. Applicators must use heat in compliance with relevant fire codes and with properly certified equipment. Additionally, applicators must hold the temperature at 120 degrees to ensure the eradication of bed bugs, monitor the temperature of the area, and properly inspect heating equipment.
