**Bill Analysis**

SB 1588 authorizes full-time and part-time state employees to donate up to 4 hours of labor per year to a 501(c)(3) organization or public school. Requests of volunteer administrative leave are subject to the approval of an agency supervisor and must be submitted at least 1 week in advance. All forms for request of volunteer administrative leave shall include a space for the signature of a representative of the charitable organization attesting to the time volunteered. No leave may be used to support a discriminatory organization. Time traveling to the volunteer event is counted towards an individual's leave. Unused volunteer administrative leave will not carry over year to year and may not be used to supplement any other type of leave including paid time off.

**Fiscal Analysis**

FY'21 Impact: Maximum of \$3.6 million

The impact would likely be minimal unless a large number of employees took the same day off and used the administrative leave. The maximum impact would be approximately \$3.6 million if all 32,000 state employees were not at work at the same time.
