Bill Analysis

SB 22 authorizes any state-supported technology center approved by the Commissioner of the Department of Public Safety to be a third-party tester for Class A, B or C driving skills portion of the Oklahoma driving examination. DPS will be required to adopt a curriculum of required courses and training for third-party testers as well as conduct a nationwide criminal history background check on each third-party tester and applicant. Costs for the background check will be borne by the applicants and testers.
