SB 451 removes the limit on the State Fire Marshal Revolving Fund. The limit allowed by current law capped the fund at \$550,000.00.

Senate Bill 451 removes the cap on the amount of funds that can be in the “State Fire Marshal Revolving Fund”, which is currently at \$550,000.

According to the State Fire Marshal’s office, this change is revolving fund language clean-up the State Auditor suggested the agency obtain from several audits ago. Staff would also recommend this change due to the agency becoming non-appropriated. Non-appropriated agencies are expected to weather changes in their revenue and expenses from year to year on their own (as opposed to asking for an appropriation increase or supplemental).
