Bill Analysis

SB 523 authorizes the creation of a batterers intervention and treatment pilot program by a district attorney or district judge. The program may enroll no more than 250 participants. The program must produce a quarterly report to the district attorney, district judge, and the Attorney General that includes all pertinent data required by the Attorney General for batterers intervention programs certified by the Attorney General. The program must also issue an annual report to the legislature that includes completion rates and information provided in the quarterly report. All reports must comply with collection and confidentiality standards.
