Bill Analysis

SB 553 modifies eligibility to receive funding from the Rural Economic Action Plan grant program. The maximum population is increased from 7,000 to 15,000 persons for eligibility. Additionally, prioritized grants will be awarded to towns with a maximum population of 7,000, an increase from the current limit of 1,750.
