**Bill Analysis**

SB 768 directs the State Department of Health to develop and implement a medical marijuana testing program to test for contaminants and for concentrations of tetrahydrocannabinol (THC), cannabidiol (CBD), and any other chemicals deemed necessary by the Department. The Department is also directed to develop a licensing process for laboratories conducting the tests. Licensed growers and processors are responsible for ensuring every batch grown or processed is tested.
