6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to motor vehicles; defining terms;  
8 providing for issuance of certificates of title for  
9 certain vintage vehicles; imposing fee for issuance  
10 of vintage vehicle certificate of title; providing  
11 fee amount nonrefundable; requiring certain  
information to be verified; providing for  
applicability of motor vehicle excise tax; providing  
for applicability of certain sales tax; providing for  
codification; and providing an effective date.

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14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
16 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1112.1A of Title 47, unless  
17 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

18 A. As used in this section "vintage vehicle" means a passenger  
19 automobile or truck having no more than two axles and for which no  
20 Oklahoma certificate of title exists in the records of the Oklahoma  
21 Tax Commission prior to January 1, 1980, and which has not been  
22 registered in the records of the Oklahoma Tax Commission or any  
23 other state for a period of fifteen (15) or more years prior to the  
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1 date as of which the application for the certificate of title is  
2 made.

3 B. A person or other legal entity may register a vintage  
4 vehicle and obtain an Oklahoma certificate of title for the vehicle  
5 upon payment of a fee of Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$250.00) and  
6 providing a verified statement, under oath, submitted to the  
7 Oklahoma Tax Commission with the following information:

8 1. The name of the person or other legal entity to which the  
9 certificate of title will be issued;

10 2. The personal or business address at which the vehicle will  
11 be located when not in use on the roads and highways of the state;

12 3. The manufacturer of the vehicle whether or not the  
13 manufacturer is still conducting business;

14 4. The model of the vehicle using either the designation  
15 provided by the original manufacturer or an equivalent designation;

16 5. The Vehicle Identification Number (VIN) if the vehicle had a  
17 VIN at the time of its original manufacture;

18 6. The price at which the vintage vehicle was acquired by the  
19 person or other legal entity making application for a vintage  
20 vehicle title; and

21 7. A statement that the vehicle is not currently subject to the  
22 lien of any person or other legal entity for the purchase price of  
23 the vehicle, for expenses associated with repair or refurbishment of  
24 the vehicle, storage charges or any other purpose.

1 C. The fee prescribed by subsection B of this section shall be  
2 nonrefundable even if the Oklahoma Tax Commission denies the  
3 issuance of a certificate of title for the vintage vehicle for any  
4 reason.

5 D. Upon review of the information contained in the application  
6 for a certificate of title, the Oklahoma Tax Commission shall  
7 determine whether or not the title may be issued.

8 E. If a vintage vehicle certificate of title is issued, the  
9 person or other legal entity making application shall make payment  
10 of the motor vehicle excise tax required by Section 2103 of Title 68  
11 of the Oklahoma Statutes and the applicable rate of sales tax  
12 imposed pursuant to Section 1354 of Title 68 of the Oklahoma  
13 Statutes.

14 F. Once a certificate of title has been issued for a vintage  
15 vehicle as provided by this section, the vehicle shall be subject to  
16 the annual registration requirements in the same manner and subject  
17 to the same fees as provided by law for other motor vehicles.

18 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
