6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to motor vehicles; allowing for
8 certain vehicles to not participate in certain
9 federal identification system; defining terms;
10 providing for certain restrictions for exemption to
11 certain federal identification system; providing for
12 codification; and providing an effective date.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1133.4 of Title 47, unless there
16 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 A. No state agency, unless required under federal law, shall
18 require any single or combination farm use vehicle included in this
19 section to participate in the United States Department of
20 Transportation identification numbering system.

21 B. For the purposes of this section, single or combination farm
22 use vehicle is a vehicle or vehicles with a gross combined weight
23 rating of more than twenty-six thousand one (26,001) pounds if:

24 1. It is entitled to be registered with a farm tag and has a
25 farm tag attached thereto;

1 2. It is controlled and operated by a farmer or rancher, his or
2 her family or employees;

3 3. It is used to transport either agricultural products,
4 livestock, farm machinery, farm supplies or any combination of those
5 materials to or from a farm;

6 4. It is not used in the operations of a common or contract
7 motor carrier;

8 5. It is used within this state or within one hundred fifty
9 (150) air miles of the person's farm or ranch if traveling out of
10 state; and

11 6. It is not transporting hazardous materials as defined under
12 the Oklahoma Motor Carrier Safety and Hazardous Materials
13 Transportation Act.

14 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
