6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to roads and bridges; amending 69
8 O.S. 2011, Section 1101, which relates to letting
9 contracts; providing for certain preference for
10 certain contract awarding procedure; updating
11 statutory language; and providing an effective date.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 69 O.S. 2011, Section 1101, is
14 amended to read as follows:

15 Section 1101. A. All contracts for construction work upon the
16 state highway system shall be let and awarded pursuant to the
17 provisions of the Public Competitive Bidding Act of 1974; provided
18 that if construction contracts are bid on by two or more companies
19 and the bids are within five percent (5%) of the other bids, then
20 preference may be given to a company whose headquarters is located
21 within the State of Oklahoma. If the project advertised pursuant to
22 the provisions of the Public Competitive Bidding Act of 1974 is for
23 the construction of more than eight (8) miles of road, and is not a
24 surface treatment only project, ~~said~~ the advertisement shall provide

1 for bids on sections of the road no longer than eight (8) miles, as
2 well as bids on the project as a whole. If the project advertised
3 pursuant to the provisions of the Public Competitive Bidding Act of
4 1974 is a surface treatment only project of more than twenty (20)
5 miles of road, the advertisement shall provide for bids on sections
6 of the road no longer than twenty (20) miles, as well as bids on the
7 project as a whole.

8 B. The Department may extend a contract no more than twenty-
9 five percent (25%) of the length and extent of the original project.
10 The price for the extension work shall not be greater than the
11 contract unit basis.

12 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
