L7	A. Each assisted living center shall annually provide to each

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        4. The means by which influenza is spread.
    Making available the appropriate and current Vaccine Information
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    Statement as provided by the Centers for Disease Control and
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    Prevention shall be deemed compliance with this subsection.
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        B. Nothing in this section shall be construed to require an
    assisted living center to provide or pay for any immunization
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    against influenza for its residents.
        C. No person shall have a cause of action for any loss or
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    damage caused by any act or omission resulting from providing, or
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    the lack of providing, educational information pursuant to this act.
            The assisted living center's license shall not be affected
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    due to the providing or lack of providing the educational
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    information pursuant to this act.
        SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
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
