6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to vaccinations; amending 70 O.S.
8 2011, Section 1210.192, which relates to exemptions;
9 requiring school districts to report certain
10 information to State Department of Health; specifying
11 submission date and minimum required information;
12 directing promulgation of rules; providing an
13 effective date; and declaring an emergency.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 70 O.S. 2011, Section 1210.192, is
16 amended to read as follows:

17 Section 1210.192. A. Any minor child, through the parent,
18 guardian, or legal custodian of the child, may submit to the health
19 authority charged with the enforcement of the immunization laws of
20 this state:

21 1. A certificate of a licensed physician as defined in Section
22 725.2 of Title 59 of the Oklahoma Statutes, stating that the
23 physical condition of the child is such that immunization would
24 endanger the life or health of the child; or

1 2. A written statement by the parent, guardian or legal
2 custodian of the child objecting to immunization of the child;
3 whereupon the child shall be exempt from the immunization laws of
4 this state.

5 B. Each school district in this state shall report the number
6 and type of exemptions from vaccinations as provided by subsection A
7 of this section to the State Department of Health. Such information
8 shall be submitted to the Department on or before July 1 of each
9 year, and shall include information from the most recently completed
10 school year.

11 C. The State Board of Education and the State Commissioner of
12 Health shall promulgate rules to implement this section.

13 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2019.

14 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
15 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
16 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
17 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
