A new section of law to be codified 8 NEW LAW 9 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.308 of Title 69, unless 10 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: The bridge over Elk Creek on State Highway 9 located 11 12 approximately one (1) mile west of Hobart in Kiowa County shall be 13 designated as the "WWII Doolittle Raider - Bombardier Sgt. Robert 14 James "R.J." Stephens Memorial Bridge". The Department of 15 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that 16 name to be placed on the bridge. 17 SECTION 2.
