11 An Act relating to the Department of Human Services;
12 limiting applications for certain home- and
13 community-based services; requiring the promulgation
of rules; providing for codification; providing an
effective date; and declaring an emergency.

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16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

17 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
18 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2005 of Title 56, unless there
19 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

20 Applications for Home and Community Based Medicaid Waiver
21 Services for the Community Waiver, In-Home Supports Waiver for
22 Adults, and In-Home Supports Waiver for Children operated by the
23 Department of Human Services shall not be made until an applicant
24 has been a resident of Oklahoma for five (5) years prior to the date

1 of application. The Department of Human Services shall promulgate
2 rules as necessary for the implementation and administration of the
3 provisions of this section.

4 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2021.

5 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
6 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
7 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
8 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
