12	An Act relating to the Office of Juvenile Affairs; requiring that certain appropriated funds be used for
13	certain purpose; requiring certain funds be used to supplement and not replace existing funding;
14	providing for lapse of funds under certain conditions; requiring certain budget procedures; and
15	prohibiting certain budget procedures.
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18	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
19	SECTION 1. From the funds appropriated to the Office of
20	Juvenile Affairs in Enrolled House Bill No. 2900 of the 1st Session
21	of the 58th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of One Million Five
22	Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$1,500,000.00) shall be used to increase
23	the funding of the Community Based Youth Services Division of the
24	Office of Juvenile Affairs above the actual expenditure levels for

1 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2021. This funding shall be used to 2 supplement rather than replace existing funding.

SECTION 2. Appropriations made by Enrolled House Bill No. 2900 3 of the 1st Session of the 58th Oklahoma Legislature, not including 4 5 appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for 6 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2022 (hereafter FY-22) or may be 7 budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2023 (hereafter FY-23). 8 Funds budgeted for FY-22 may be encumbered only through June 30, 9 2022, and must be expended by November 15, 2022. Any funds 10 remaining after November 15, 2022, and not budgeted for FY-23, shall 11 lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal 12 year. Funds budgeted for FY-23 may be encumbered only through June 13 30, 2023. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2023, shall lapse 14 to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year. 15 These appropriations may not be budgeted in both fiscal years 16 simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-22, and not required to pay 17 obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-23, after 18 the agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared 19 and submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds 20 from the FY-22 budget work program and after such revision has been 21 approved by the Office of Management and Enterprise Services. 22 23

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
