10	An Act relating to trespassing; amending 21 O.S. 2011, Section 1835, which relates to the penalty for		
11	trespassing after being forbidden; modifying statutory language; providing certain exceptions; providing for allowances; providing for criminal		
12			
13	offense; providing for penalty; deleting certain definition; and providing an effective date.

16	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:		
17	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 21 O.S. 2011, Section 1835, is		
18	amended to read as follows:		
19	Section 1835. A. Whoever shall willfully or maliciously enter		
20	the garden, yard, pasture or field of another after being expressly		
21	forbidden to do so or without permission by the owner or lawful		
22	occupant thereof when such property is posted shall be deemed guilty		
23	of trespass and upon conviction <del>thereof</del> shall be <del>fined in any sum</del>		
24	punished by a fine of not <del>to exceed</del> more than Two Hundred Fifty		

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1 Dollars (\$250.00); provided, that this provision shall not apply to registered land surveyors and registered professional engineers for 2 3 the purpose of land surveying in the performance of their professional services; and, provided further, that anyone who 4 5 willfully or maliciously enters any such garden, yard, pasture or field, and therein commits or attempts to commit waste, theft, or 6 7 damage shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be fined in any sum not less than Fifty Dollars 8 9 (\$50.00) nor more than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00), or by 10 confinement in the county jail for not less than thirty (30) days 11 nor more than six (6) months, or both such fine and imprisonment. 12 For purposes of this section, "posted" means exhibiting signs to 13 read as follows: "PROPERTY RESTRICTED"; "POSTED - KEEP OUT"; "KEEP OUT"; "NO TRESPASSING"; or similar signs which are displayed. 14 15 Property that is fenced or not fenced must have such signs placed 16 conspicuously and at all places where entry to the property is normally expected. 17 1. 12	be punished by imprisonment in the county jail for a term of not		
13	less than thirty (30) days nor more than six (6) months, by a fine		
14	of not less than Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) nor more than Five Hundred		
15	Dollars (\$500.00), or by both such fine and imprisonment.		
16	B. C. No provisions of this act section shall be construed to		
17	conflict with Section 5-202 or 6-304 of Title 29 of the Oklahoma		
18	Statutes.

D. E. Whoever shall willfully or maliciously enter upon 7 property owned or managed by the Grand River Dam Authority without 8 9 permission when such property is posted shall be deemed guilty of 10 misdemeanor trespass and upon conviction thereof shall be fined in 11 any sum punished by a fine of not to exceed more than Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$250.00); provided, that this provision shall not 12 apply to registered land surveyors and registered professional 13 engineers for the purpose of land surveying in the performance of 14 their professional services; and, provided further, that anyone who 15 willfully or maliciously enters upon property owned or managed by 16 the Grand River Dam Authority without permission and therein commits 17 or attempts to commit waste, theft<sub> $\tau$ </sub> or damage shall be deemed guilty 18 of misdemeanor trespass, and upon conviction thereof shall be fined 19 in any sum punished by a fine of not less than Fifty Dollars 20 (\$50.00) nor more than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00), or by 21 confinement imprisonment in the county jail for not less than thirty 22 (30) days nor more than six (6) months, or by both such fine and 23 imprisonment. For purposes of this section, "posted" means 24

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1 exhibiting signs to read as follows: "PROPERTY RESTRICTED"; "POSTED
2 - KEEP OUT"; "KEEP OUT"; "NO TRESPASSING"; or similar signs which
3 are displayed. Property that is fenced or not fenced must have such
4 signs placed conspicuously and at all places where entry to the
5 property is normally expected.

6 E. F. Notwithstanding the provisions of this section, the 7 Governor's Mansion and its grounds and appurtenances shall not be required to be posted with signs warning against trespass. Any 8 9 person who shall willfully or maliciously enter the grounds of the 10 Governor's Mansion within the State Capitol Park, as defined in Section 1811.4 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes, except at a 11 12 place where entry to the property is normally expected shall be 13 deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be fined in a sum punished by a fine of not more than Five Hundred Dollars 14 (\$500.00), or by confinement imprisonment in the county jail for not 15 less than thirty (30) days nor more than six (6) months, or by both 16 17 such fine and imprisonment.
